# Certificate of Inspection

This vessel has been granted a fresh water service examination interval in accordance with 46 CFR 137.300(a)(2) If this vessel is operated in salt water more than 6 months in any 12 month period, the vessel must be inspected using salt water intervals per 46 CFR 137.300(a)(1) and the cognizant OCMI must be notified in writing as soon as this change in status occurs.

One 40-B portable fire extinguisher, in addition to those required by Table 142.230(a) must be located near the flammable storage room or cabinet.

Prior to getting underway, the master or officer in charge of a navigational watch shall ensure that the vessel is in compliance with the stability requirements for the intended route and service.

In the event the master becomes incapacitated, the deckhand shall be capable of returning the vessel safely to port. The deckhand shall be capable of directing emergency response actions. The station bill must supplement the deckhand's emergency duties when the deckhand is performing other duties associated with this provision or provide an additional qualified deckhand.
